3. Committee: Committee Referral Pending

4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; annual mixed beverage performing arts facility licenses.

5. Summary: Allows the Board of Directors of the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority to issue annual mixed beverage performing arts facility licenses to persons operating food concessions at the following venues:

- Any performing arts facility located in the City of Charlottesville that (i) is occupied under a bona fide long-term lease or concession agreement, the original term of which was more than five years, (ii) has a total capacity in excess of 550 patrons, and (iii) has been rehabilitated accordance with historic preservation standards;
- Any outdoor performing arts amphitheater, arena, or similar facility that has seating for more than 5,000 persons and is located in the City of Richmond; and
- Any outdoor performing arts amphitheater, arena, or similar facility located in the City of Charlottesville that has seating for more than 2,500 persons.
