3. **Committee:** Committee Referral Pending

4. **Title:** Administrative Process Act; executive branch agencies.

5. **Summary:** Requires executive branch agencies to ensure that certain regulations and guidance documents under the Virginia Register Act and Administrative Process Act, as appropriate, are posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall according to instructions issued by the Department of Planning and Budget.

6. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

7. **Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary; no state fiscal impact.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** The proposed legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact as executive branch agencies have been required to post their regulations and guidance documents on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall per Executive Order 19 (2022), *Development and Review of State Agency Regulations*, and its predecessors. As such, this bill would codify a current practice that is already performed by existing staff at the affected agencies.

9. **Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** All executive branch agencies that have regulations and/or guidance documents; the Department of Planning and Budget.
