3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Security camera monitoring by law-enforcement agencies.

5. Summary: This bill provides that any law-enforcement agency having jurisdiction over criminal law enforcement or regulatory violations may establish a program to allow for the monitoring or reviewing of security cameras, as defined in the bill, for the purpose of tracking and reducing crime by such law-enforcement agency. The bill requires that any law-enforcement agency establishing such program shall develop a policy for how such security cameras will be monitored and how such data from such security cameras will be used and maintained. The bill also provides that such program may allow any resident or business or commercial establishment within the Commonwealth that owns a security camera to opt into the monitoring program.
