1. **Bill Number:** HB1513H1

2. **Patron:** Fowler

3. **Committee:** Public Safety

4. **Title:** Active-duty status for any service member injured while in the line of duty.

5. **Summary:** Authorizes the adjutant General to maintain state active-duty status for any service member injured while in the line of duty during the course of a state active-duty mission who is unable, due to their injury, to return to civil employment. Such authorization is limited to 90 days after the date of the service member's injury. The pay and allowances to the service member will be equal to the lesser of (i) the amount that the service member received from their civilian employment prior to their mobilization or (ii) the amount of federal active duty pay and allowances for that service member's rank and years of service.

6. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** Indeterminate.

7. **Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary, see Item 8 below.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Military Affairs (DMA), there is insufficient data to estimate how many servicemembers will be activated for state active duty (SAD) and injured while deployed each year. As such, the fiscal impact to the sum sufficient is indeterminate at this time.
