**3. Committee:** Passed both houses

**4. Title:** Certain school board property; establishment of gun-free zone permitted.

**5. Summary:** Permits any school board to deem any non-school zone building or property that it owns or leases as a gun-free zone and prohibit any individual from knowingly possessing any firearm while such individual is upon such property, except certain individuals such as law-enforcement officers, qualified retired law-enforcement officers, any individual who possesses an unloaded firearm that is in a closed container in or upon a motor vehicle or an unloaded shotgun or rifle in a firearms rack in or upon a motor vehicle, or any individual who has a valid concealed handgun permit and possesses a concealed handgun while in a motor vehicle in a parking lot, traffic circle, or other means of vehicular ingress to or egress from the school board property.
