**4. Title:** Department of General Services; Division of Purchases and Supply; disposition of surplus materials.

**5. Summary:** Permits the Department of General Services to establish procedures for a buy-back or trade-in agreement with a purchasing vendor for surplus technological equipment.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary—indeterminate, see item 8

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of General Services (DGS) indicates that the fiscal impact from this bill is indeterminate, as the cost savings are unknown from the agreements with vendors. The bill directs DGS only to establish procedures for buy-back and trade-in agreements for surplus technological equipment and the agency has not yet determined or established those procedures.
