- **3.** Committee: General Laws and Technology
- **4. Title:** Virginia Public Procurement Act; public higher educational institutions, disclosure by offerors.
- **5. Summary:** Requires every offeror who submits a proposal to a public institution of higher education for any construction project that (i) has a total cost of \$5 million or more and (ii) uses a procurement method other than competitive sealed bidding to disclose any contributions the offeror has made within the previous five-year period totaling \$25,000 or more to the public institution of higher education or any private foundation that exists solely to support the public institution of higher education. The bill imposes a \$500 civil penalty on any offeror that knowingly fails to submit the required disclosure.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation is not expected to generate a state fiscal impact. Offerors who fail to submit the disclosure required by the bill are subject to a \$500 civil penalty, to be paid into the state general fund, however, the number of such incidents and subsequent civil penalty payments is indeterminate.
- **9.** Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All public institutions of higher education
