3. Committee: Passed both Houses

4. Title: Substantial risk orders; substantial risk factors and considerations.

5. Summary: This bill establishes various factors that a judge or magistrate must consider for the purpose of determining probable cause prior to issuing an emergency substantial risk order or a substantial risk order. The bill also provides that possession of a firearm includes actual access or the potential to readily access a firearm including firearms that are located or stored at the residence of the subject and firearms that are secured in a locked container, compartment, or cabinet that is inaccessible to such person regardless of whether the firearm is owned by another person.
