7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to specify that
8	motor vehicles registered as pleasure cars shall only be required to display a
9	rear license plate.
10	An act relating to the display of license plates on pleasure cars
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 511 is amended to read:
13	§ 511. MANNER OF DISPLAY
14	(a) A motor vehicle operated on any highway shall have displayed in a
15	conspicuous place either one or two number plates as the Commissioner may
16	require, except that a vehicle registered at the pleasure car rate shall not be
17	required to display more than one plate. Such The number plates shall be
18	furnished by the Commissioner and shall show the number assigned to such
19	the vehicle by the Commissioner. If only one number plate is furnished, the

same it shall be securely attached to the rear of the vehicle. If two are

1 furnished, one shall be securely attached to the rear and one to the front of the 2 vehicle. The number plates shall be kept entirely unobscured, and the 3 numerals and the letters thereon shall be plainly legible at all times. They shall 4 be kept horizontal, shall be so fastened as not to swing, excepting however, 5 except that there may be installed on a motor truck or truck tractor a device 6 which would, upon contact with a substantial object, permit the rear number 7 plate to swing toward the front of the vehicle, provided such that the device 8 automatically returns the number plate to its original rigid position after 9 contact is released, and the ground clearance of the lower edges thereof shall 10 be established by the Commissioner pursuant to the provisions of 3 V.S.A. 11 chapter 25.

- (c) A person shall not operate a motor vehicle unless <u>a</u> number <u>plate or</u> plates and a validation sticker are displayed as provided in this section.

- 16 § 514. REPLACEMENT NUMBER PLATES
 - (a) In case of the loss of a number plate, the owner of the motor vehicle to which it was assigned shall forthwith notify the Commissioner of Motor

 Vehicles of such the loss, and he or she shall furnish such the owner with a new plate. The fees charged shall be \$12.00 for each plate. The owner of a motor vehicle required to display front and rear number plates who has lost one

1	number plate may operate his or her vehicle with one number plate attached
2	thereto, until a new plate is furnished him or her, provided he or she has
3	notified the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles as required in this section.
