18	and Independent Living, the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman, the
19	Community of Vermont Elders, AARP Vermont, the VNAs of Vermont, the
20	Vermont Health Care Association, and other interested stakeholders, shall

1	evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of allowing Vermont residents to
2	purchase Long-Term Care Partnership policies.
3	(b) On or before December 15, 2021, the Department of Financial
4	Regulation shall report its findings and recommendations regarding Long-
5	Term Care Partnership policies, including a recommendation on whether
6	Vermont residents should be allowed to purchase them, to the House
7	Committees on Human Services and on Commerce and Economic
8	Development and the Senate Committees on Health and Welfare and on
9	Finance.
