7	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to create the Connecticut River
8	valley development zone, consisting of municipalities that border the
9	Connecticut and Passumpsic Rivers and additional municipalities deemed
10	appropriate by the agency of commerce and community development. A
11	Connecticut River valley development fund is also created, under which
12	municipalities in the Connecticut River valley development zone shall be
13	eligible to receive disbursements to: promote travel and tourism; encourage
14	economic development and investment; create and retain employment; and
15	improve public facilities in support of tourism or economic development. The
16	fund shall include one percent of the revenues from the state sales and use tax.
17	The allocation to the general fund is reduced from two-thirds of revenues from
18	the sales and use tax to 66 percent of revenues. The allocation to the education
19	fund is reduced from one-third of revenues from the sales and use tax to 33
20	percent of revenues. An advisory committee also is created to review
21	disbursements from the fund.

14	(a) A fund to be known as the Connecticut River valley economic
15	development fund is created in the state treasury to be expended by the
16	secretary of commerce and community development. The fund shall consist
17	<u>of:</u>
18	(1) one percent of the revenues raised from the sales and use tax
19	imposed by chapter 233 of Title 32;

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1	(2) such sums as may be appropriated or transferred to the fund by the
2	general assembly, the state emergency board, or the joint fiscal committee
3	during such times that the general assembly is not in session;
4	(3) private gifts, bequests, and donations made to the state for any of the
5	purposes for which the fund was established; and
6	(4) other funds from any public or private source intended for use for
7	any of the purposes for which the fund has been established.
8	(b) After application by a municipality located in the Connecticut River
9	valley economic development zone, the secretary may authorize disbursements
10	from the fund to promote travel and tourism; encourage economic
11	development and investment; create and retain employment; and improve
12	public facilities in support of tourism or economic development. The secretary
13	may prescribe by rule any form of application or procedure required of a
14	municipality for disbursement.
15	(c) The secretary shall establish a Connecticut River valley development
16	zone advisory committee to review disbursements from the fund and to
17	evaluate the effectiveness of the fund in meeting its purposes. The
18	membership of the advisory committee shall include one member from each
19	municipality within the zone. Any member shall serve for a term of three
20	years.
