12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
13	Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 1673 is amended to read:
14	§ 1673. PROHIBITIONS
15	(a) A person shall not alter, expand, or otherwise modify an existing public
16	water system or public water source without a permit from the secretary
17	Secretary.
18	(b) A person shall not construct a new public water system or public water
19	source or change an existing water system or source into a public water system
20	or public water source without a permit from the secretary Secretary.

1	(c) A person shall not operate a public water system or public water source
2	without a permit from the secretary Secretary.
3	(d) As of July 1, 1993, a person shall not operate a public water system
4	unless the secretary Secretary has certified the person as a public water system
5	operator pursuant to this chapter.
6	(e) A person shall not operate or maintain a public water system or public
7	water source in a manner that causes or allows that system or source to be at
8	risk of damage or contamination.
9	(f) A person shall not sell imported or domestic containerized, bottled, or
10	packaged drinking water in the state State of Vermont unless:
11	(1) the water and the source and system of the imported water is
12	regulated by drinking water standards or requirements substantially equivalent
13	to or more stringent than standards or requirements established by the secretary
14	Secretary pursuant to subsection 1672(b) of this title, and the importer of the
15	water has presented certification of such standards;
16	(2) the water and the source and system of the domestic drinking water
17	meet the standards or requirements established by the secretary Secretary
18	pursuant to subsection 1672(b) of this title; and
19	(3) the name, source, and the location of the bottler of spring, artesian,
20	or municipal water are identified.

- 1 (g) A person shall not use an internal combustion motor on a public water
- 2 <u>source that is a lake, pond, or reservoir other than Lake Champlain or Lake</u>
- 3 <u>Memphremagog.</u> The prohibition on the use of internal combustion motors
- 4 <u>shall include the use of an internal combustion motor to power a vessel and the</u>
