- The school board of a school district, in addition to other duties and authority specifically assigned by law:

7 ***

- (5) Shall keep the school buildings and grounds in good repair, suitably equipped, insured, and in safe and sanitary condition at all times. The school board shall adopt policies to regulate or prohibit firearms or other dangerous or deadly weapons on school premises and, as part of a comprehensive response to violation of these policies, may require a student to receive counseling or to participate in appropriate community-based programs or both. At a minimum, a school board shall adopt and implement a policy at least consistent with section 1166 of this title and 13 V.S.A. § 4004, relating to a student who brings a firearm to or possesses a firearm at school. For purposes of this subdivision, the definitions of "firearm" and "dangerous or deadly weapon" are the same as in 13 V.S.A. § 4016.
