19	(E) No Except for flood hazard area bylaws adopted pursuant to
20	section 4424 of this title, no bylaw shall have the effect of excluding as a

permitted use one accessory dwelling unit that is located within or appurtenant
to an owner-occupied single-family dwelling. An accessory dwelling unit
means an efficiency or one-bedroom apartment that is clearly subordinate to a
single-family dwelling, and has facilities and provisions for independent living,
including sleeping, food preparation, and sanitation, provided there is
compliance with all the following:
(i) The property has sufficient wastewater capacity.
(ii) The unit does not exceed 30 percent of the total habitable floor
area of the single-family dwelling.
(iii) Applicable setback, coverage, and parking requirements
specified in the bylaws are met.
(F) Nothing in subdivision (1)(E) of this section shall be construed to
prohibit:
(i) a bylaw that is less restrictive of accessory dwelling units;
(ii) a bylaw that requires conditional use review for one or more of
the following that is involved in creation of an accessory dwelling unit:
(I) a new accessory structure;
(II) an increase in the height or floor area of the existing
dwelling; or
(III) an increase in the dimensions of the parking areas.
