17	operating noise level to not more than 82 decibels on the A scale at 50 feet, in		
18	a normal operating environment 75 decibels on the A scale ("dBA") when		
19	subjected to a shoreline sound level measurement test as prescribed by Society		
20	of Automotive Engineers (SAE) standard J1970, as may be amended, or

1	90 dBA when subjected to a stationary sound level measurement test as
2	prescribed by SAE standard J2005, as may be amended.
3	(b) A person shall not manufacture or offer for sale in this state, or permit
4	to be operated or operate on the public waters of this state, any motorboat that
5	exceeds the noise levels established in subsection (a) of this section.
6	(c) The use of muffler cutouts is prohibited except for motorboats
7	competing in a regatta or boat race approved as provided in section 3316 of
8	this title, and for such motorboats while on trial runs, during a period not to
9	exceed 48 hours immediately preceding such regatta or race and for such
10	motorboats while competing in official trials for speed records during a period
11	not to exceed 48 hours immediately following such regatta or race.
12	(d) Any officer authorized to enforce the provisions of this section who has
13	reason to believe that a motorboat is not in compliance with the noise levels
14	established in this section may direct the operator of the motorboat to submit it
15	to an on-site test to measure the noise level, with the officer on board if he or
16	she so chooses. If the motorboat exceeds the noise levels established in this
17	section, the officer may direct the operator to take immediate and reasonable
18	measures to correct the violation, including returning the motorboat to a
19	mooring and keeping the motorboat at such mooring until the violation is
