15	U.S. Admiral George Dewey, the only person to attain the rank of Admiral

17	U.S. Navy hero, whose military leadership resulted in the destruction of the
18	Spanish fleet in Manila Bay, the Philippines, during the Spanish-American
19	War of 1898. The original Dewey Day celebration occurred in Montpelier on
20	October 12, 1899. In 2018, the Governor issued an executive order
