| 17 | U.S. Navy hero, whose military leadership resulted in the destruction of the |
| 18 | Spanish fleet in Manila Bay, the Philippines, during the Spanish-American |
| 19 | War of 1898. The original Dewey Day celebration occurred in Montpelier on |
