16	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to increase the
17	annual appropriation for Vermont State Colleges by \$4,000,000.00 in fiscal
18	year 2018 and to adjust future year appropriations for Vermont State Colleges
19	in relation to changes in the "Total General Government" section of the State
20	budget.

1	An act relating to appropriations for Vermont State Colleges
2	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
3	Sec. 1. APPROPRIATION FOR VERMONT STATE COLLEGES
4	The General Fund appropriation for the Vermont State Colleges for fiscal
5	year 2018 shall be \$28,300,464.00, an increase of \$4,000,000.00 over the
6	appropriation for fiscal year 2017.
7	Sec. 2. 16 V.S.A. § 2171 is amended to read:
8	§ 2171. CORPORATION ESTABLISHED; PURPOSES; POWERS
9	(a) There is created as a part of the educational system of the State of
10	Vermont a public corporation to be known as "Vermont State Colleges" or any
11	other name that the Board of Trustees, established under section 2172 of this
12	chapter, selects at a meeting duly warned for that purpose, provided that the
13	word "Vermont" shall appear in the selected name. The Corporation shall plan,
14	supervise, administer, and operate facilities for education at the postsecondary
15	level supported in whole or in substantial part with State funds; however, while
16	the Corporation shall maintain cooperative relations with the University of
17	Vermont and State Agricultural College, nothing in this chapter shall give the
18	Corporation any responsibility for the planning, supervision, administration, or
19	operation of the University. The annual State General Fund appropriation for
20	the Vermont State Colleges for fiscal year 2019 and each succeeding fiscal
21	year shall be increased or decreased by an expense adjustment, which shall

1	equal the immediately preceding five-year average change in the annual "Total
2	General Government" section of the State budget. If the Total General
3	Government section of the State budget changes in presentation or format, the
4	total of the items comprising this section, however presented, shall be used in
5	calculating the expense adjustment.
