Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to repeal the
Governor's authority to propose by Executive Order changes in the
organization of the Executive Branch of government.

An act relating to reorganization of the Executive Branch by Executive
Order

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 3 V.S.A. § 2001 is amended to read:

§ 2001. POWER OF GOVERNOR

The Governor may make such changes in the organization of the Executive
Branch or in the assignment of functions among its units as he or she considers
necessary for efficient administration. The Governor's authority under this
section does not extend to changes that are inconsistent with or contrary to
existing organization or assignment of functions provided for by law.

2 (a) 3 V.S.A. § 2002 (Executive Orders) is repealed.

3 (b) 3 V.S.A. § 2003 (transfer of personnel and appropriations) is repealed.

4 (c) 3 V.S.A. § 2004 (terms of Governor's appointees) is repealed.

5 (d) 3 V.S.A. § 2005 (continuing functions) is repealed.

6 (e) 3 V.S.A. § 2006 (prospective effect) is repealed.

7 (f) 3 V.S.A. § 2007 (effective date of transfers) is repealed.

8 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
