13	§ 384. EMPLOYMENT; WAGES

15	(d)(1) The hours that emergency personnel are on call and being paid less
16	than their regular wage rate shall not count toward their total work week hours
17	for the purposes of determining the payment of overtime wages.
18	(2) For the purposes of this subsection, "emergency personnel" shall
19	have the same definition as in 20 V.S.A. § 3171, except that it shall not include
20	volunteer personnel.
