9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the

14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	Sec. 1. POLE ATTACHMENT RULES; PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD
16	On or before June 1, 2017, the Public Service Board shall initiate a
17	rulemaking proceeding to revise its rules governing pole attachments, Rule
18	3.700, et seq., with the goal of expediting the use of facilities by
19	telecommunications service providers able to offer and expand broadband
20	throughout the State. Among other things, the Board shall consider:

1	(1) one touch make-ready policies for pole attachments;
2	(2) the June 29, 2015 petition of the Maine Office of the Public
3	Advocate filed with the Maine Public Utilities Commission; in particular,
4	Attachment A to the petition and its proposed revisions to Maine's pole
5	attachment rules;
6	(3) measures designed to minimize delays and costs and promote fair
7	and reasonable rates and the rapid resolution of disputes; and
8	(4) any other standards or procedures deemed relevant by the Board.
9	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
10	This act shall take effect on passage.
