An act relating to establishing a Dementia Coordinator

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| 1  | It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:            |

| 5  | § 3055. DEMENTIA COORDINATOR   |
| 6  | (a) There is created the permanent position of Dementia Coordinator within       |
| 7  | the Agency of Human Services for the purpose of coordinating, across State       |
| 8  | government and in collaboration with community partners, policies, programs,     |
| 9  | and budgets to support and improve the well-being of all Vermonters              |
| 10 | experiencing dementia and their families. The Dementia Coordinator shall:        |
| 11 | (1) update, report on, and implement the State Action Plan for                   |
| 12 | Alzheimer's Disease, Related Dementias, and Healthy Aging;                       |
| 13 | (2) identify and apply for grant opportunities to expand the scope of            |
| 14 | services to individuals with dementia, their families, and caregivers;           |
| 15 | (3) establish and maintain relationships with other agencies and                 |
| 16 | organizations within the State in order to meet the needs of individuals with    |
| 17 | dementia and their families;   |
| 18 | (4) streamline all applicable State government services to prevent               |
