Subject: Judiciary; law enforcement; nonbiased policing

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create a
department of eight to 10 individuals tasked with routinely and randomly
reviewing police body camera and police cruiser dashboard camera footage for
compliance with existing nonbiased policing policies. The work done by the
department may serve as a tool for officer oversight and training. The
department will be funded from the money saved by reducing the high cost of
storage for existing and new camera footage.
