Subject: Professions and occupations; license applications; conviction history

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to add statewide standards for the licensure of applicants with criminal conviction histories to 26 V.S.A. chapter 57. This bill also proposes to require that each State regulatory entity provide a biennial report which contains the number of licenses denied based on an applicant's criminal conviction history, along with a list of each conviction that constituted the basis for each denial.
