18	indicate or that is intended to indicate or calculated to mislead members of the
19	public into believing that he or she is qualified to apply instrumentation to
20	detect deception or to verify the truth of statements without being licensed as a

- 1 polygraph examiner as provided in this chapter. <u>This section shall not apply to</u>
- 2 <u>State or local law enforcement using a computer voice stress analyzer as an</u>
- 3 <u>investigative tool in an official law enforcement capacity.</u>
