7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to add Crohn's
8	disease, colitis, glaucoma, and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis to the conditions

10	for patients with chronic, debilitating, lifelong medical conditions to submit a
11	medical verification form upon application for the renewal of a registration

16	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

18	(4) "Debilitating medical condition," provided that, in the context of the
19	specific disease or condition described in subdivision (A) or (B) of this
20	subdivision (4), reasonable medical efforts have been made over a reasonable

amount of time without success to relieve the symptoms, means:

1	(A) cancer, <u>Crohn's disease</u> , <u>colitis</u> , <u>glaucoma</u> , <u>amyotrophic lateral</u>
2	sclerosis, multiple sclerosis, positive status for human immunodeficiency
3	virus, acquired immune deficiency syndrome, or the treatment of these
4	conditions, if the disease or the treatment results in severe, persistent, and
5	intractable symptoms; or
6	(B) a disease, medical condition, or its treatment that is chronic,
7	debilitating, and produces severe, persistent, and one or more of the following
8	intractable symptoms: cachexia or wasting syndrome; severe pain; severe
9	nausea; or seizures.

12	(a) The department Department shall collect a fee of \$50.00 for the
13	application authorized by sections 4473 and 4474 of this title. The fees
14	received by the department Department shall be deposited into a registration
15	fee fund and used to offset the costs of processing applications under this
16	subchapter.
17	(b)(1) A Except as provided in subdivisions (2) and (3) of this subsection, a
18	registration card shall expire one year after the date of issue, with the option of
19	renewal, provided the patient submits a new application which is approved by
20	the department of public safety Department of Public Safety, pursuant to
