Subject: Human services; accommodations for individuals with physical
disabilities; trail access

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that:

(1) at least 10 percent of each newly constructed trail in a State park be
accessible to individuals with physical disabilities; and (2) accessible trail
buildouts use the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Forest Service Trail
Accessibility Guidelines.
