17	(11)(A) Shall prepare and distribute annually a proposed budget for the
18	next school year according to such major categories as may from time to time
19	be prescribed by the Secretary.

1	(D) The board shall present the budget to the voters by means of a
2	ballot in the following form:
3	"Article #1 (School Budget):
4	The total proposed budget of \$ is the amount determined by the
5	school board to be necessary to support the school district's educational
6	program. Of the total proposed budget, the sum of \$ is the portion
7	of supervisory union expenditures for which the supervisory union has
8	assessed this district. Shall the voters of the school district approve the school
9	board to expend \$, which is the amount the school board has
10	determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? -It is estimated that this
11	proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$ per
12	equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is%
13	higher/lower than spending for the current year.
