14	§ 519. EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE
15	(a) A person who knows that another is exposed to grave physical harm
16	shall, to the extent that the same can be rendered without danger or peril to
17	himself or herself or without interference with important duties owed to others
18	give reasonable assistance to the exposed person unless that assistance or care
19	is being provided by others.

(b) A person who provides reasonable assistance in compliance with
subsection (a) of this section shall not be liable in civil damages unless his the
person's acts constitute gross negligence or unless he the person will receive or
expects to receive remuneration. Nothing contained in this subsection shall
alter existing law with respect to tort liability of a practitioner of the healing
arts for acts committed in the ordinary course of his or her practice.
(c) A person who willfully violates subsection (a) of this section shall be
fined not more than \$100.00 \$1,000.00.
