14 § 371. LEGAL HOLIDAYS

15 (a) The following shall be legal holidays:

16 (1) New Year's Day, January 1;

17 (2) Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday, the third Monday in January;

18 (3) Presidents' Day, the third Monday in February;

19 (4) Town Meeting Day, the first Tuesday in March;

20 (5) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
