18	3 V.S.A. § 129a and by this section as follows, whether or not taken by a
19	license holder <u>personally</u> :

1	(1) failing to provide for informed consent, or exercising undue
2	influence on or taking improper advantage of a person using midwifery
3	services;
4	(2) willfully making or filing false reports or records in the practice of
5	midwifery, obstructing that filing, or willfully failing to file required reports or
6	records, including birth certificates;
7	(3) performing a home vaginal birth with a patient who has previously
8	had a cesarean delivery; or
9	(4) engaging in abusive behavior of any kind with clients.
10	(c) After a hearing, and upon a finding of unprofessional conduct, an
11	administrative law officer may take disciplinary action against a licensed
12	midwife or applicant.
