3	§ 668. SALES AGENTS; INTERNET CONNECTIONS
4	(a) A sales agent licensed under this chapter may use the Internet
5	connection provided for a gaming system approved under this chapter to issue
6	fishing and hunting licenses under 10 V.S.A. § 4254 if the Commission
7	determines that:
8	(1) the sales agent licensed under this chapter is licensed currently under
9	10 V.S.A. chapter 105 to sell and distribute fishing and hunting licenses;
10	(2) the Internet connection provided to the sales agent licensed under
11	this chapter has capacity that can be shared;
12	(3) the Internet connection provided to the sales agent licensed under
13	this chapter is compatible with the separate terminal provided by the
14	Department of Fish and Wildlife to issue fishing and hunting licenses; and
15	(4) use of the Internet connection to issue fishing and hunting licenses
16	will not interrupt the closed loop system required for operation of a gaming

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- (f)(1) All persons or businesses who wish to serve as agents shall apply on forms provided by the department Department. All applicants who become agents, except town clerks or other municipal or state employees who sell licenses as part of their official duties, shall pay an agency origination fee of \$100.00 upon establishment of the agency. Except for the fee collected under subdivision (e)(9) of this section, all license fees collected by an agent are the property of the state State of Vermont and shall be promptly paid to the state State following the procedures established under subdivision (e)(6) of this section.
 - (2) A person licensed to sell and distribute fishing and hunting licenses under this section may apply to the State Lottery Commission under 31 V.S.A. § 668 to share the Internet connection provided to licensed lottery agents for the issuance of fishing and hunting licenses.
