Subject: Motor vehicles; wreckers; weight limits
Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to exempt a
wrecker towing a disabled vehicle from the State's gross weight limits on
highways in certain instances.

An act relating to wrecker exemption from gross weight limits on highways

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1392 is amended to read:

§ 1392. GROSS WEIGHT LIMITS ON HIGHWAYS

Except as provided in ~~section~~ sections 1400 and 1400e of this title, a person
or corporation shall not operate or cause to be operated a motor vehicle in
excess of the total weight, including vehicle, object, or contrivance and load,
of:

2 § 1400e. EXCEPTION FOR DISABLED VEHICLES BEING TOWED

3 (a) A combination of vehicles including a wrecker towing one or more
4 disabled vehicles with a total gross vehicle weight exceeding the weight
5 limitations imposed by article 1 of this subchapter may be operated on a public
6 highway in this State without a permit, provided that:

7 (1) neither the wrecker nor disabled vehicle or vehicles individually
8 exceed the weight limitations imposed by article 1 of this subchapter or are
9 lawfully operating under a blanket permit;

10 (2) there are enough axels to distribute the total gross vehicle weight at a
11 rate of 20,000 pounds per axel with dual wheels and 12,000 pounds per axel
12 with single wheels;

13 (3) the wrecker has a gross vehicle weight rating of at least 18,000
14 pounds and is equipped with air brakes if the disabled vehicle or vehicles are
15 also equipped with air brakes;

16 (4) the wrecker is equipped with flashing, rotating, or oscillating amber
17 signal lamps that are visible for at least 500 feet in all directions;

18 (5) the wrecker utilizes the lighting and braking system of the disabled
19 vehicle or vehicles; and

20 (6) the total trip distance does not exceed 75 miles.

1 (b) The operator of the wrecker operating pursuant to this section must
2 abide by all speed limitations and posted bridge and highway weight
3 limitations and may not exceed 45 miles per hour if the gross vehicle weight is
4 90,000 pounds or greater.
