8 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to repeal the
9 requirement that the State Board of Education propose candidates to the
10 Governor for the position of Secretary of Education.

11 An act relating to selection of a Secretary of Education

12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. 3 V.S.A. § 2702(a) is amended to read:

14 (a) With the advice and consent of the ~~senate~~ Senate, the ~~governor~~
15 Governor shall appoint a ~~secretary of education from among no fewer than~~
16 ~~three candidates proposed by the state board of education. The secretary~~
17 Secretary of Education who shall serve at the pleasure of the ~~governor~~
18 Governor.

19 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

20 This act shall take effect on passage.
