15	§ 7060. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY
16	(a) No A person shall not be liable in any suit for civil damages who in
17	good faith receives, develops, collects, provides, or processes information for
18	the enhanced 911 database system or develops, designs, adopts, establishes,
19	installs, participates in, implements, maintains, or provides access to telephone,
20	mobile, or IP-enabled service, delivers, or provides services, equipment, or

1	software for any telecommunications service for the purpose of helping
2	persons obtain emergency assistance in accordance with this chapter unless
3	such action constitutes gross negligence or an intentional tort.
4	(b) In addition, no a provider of telephone, mobile, or other IP-enabled
5	service any telecommunications service or a provider's respective employees,
6	directors, officers, assigns, affiliates, or agents shall <u>not</u> be liable for civil
7	damages in connection with the release of customer information to any
8	governmental entity, including any public safety answering point, as required
9	under this chapter.
10	(c) As used in this section, "telecommunications service" has the same
11	meaning as that term is defined in subdivision 203(5) of this title.
