6 Subject: Conservation and development; natural resources; air pollution

7 control; vapor recovery; gasoline stations

8 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to repeal, effective July 1, 2010, the
9 rules of the agency of natural resources pertaining to stage II vapor recovery
10 systems at gasoline stations and to prohibit the agency from issuing rules
11 requiring stage II vapor recovery controls.

12 An act relating to stage II vapor recovery systems at gasoline stations

13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 556 is amended to read:

15 § 556. PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR MODIFICATION OF
16 AIR CONTAMINANT SOURCES

18 (i) Effective July 1, 2010, all rules of the secretary pertaining to stage II
19 vapor recovery controls at gasoline dispensing facilities are repealed, including
20 section 5-253.7 of the air pollution control regulations (as adopted through

1 April 27, 2007). The secretary may not issue further rules requiring or
2 pertaining to such controls. For purposes of this subsection, “stage II vapor
3 recovery” means a system for gasoline vapor recovery of emissions from the
4 fueling of motor vehicles as described in 42 U.S.C. § 7511a(b)(3).
