9	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
10	Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 5 is added to read:
11	§ 5. LIBRARIES; BEER AND WINE EXEMPTION
12	A library may serve without a license malt and vinous beverages free of
13	charge by the individual glass to a person for consumption on the premises at
14	events open to the public, provided that at least one employee of the library has
15	received training in the service of alcoholic beverages pursuant to section 239
16	of this title. A library shall not serve malt or vinous beverages to a minor or to
17	a person who is intoxicated or who appears to be intoxicated.
18	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
