14	(a) As used in this section, "public transit bus" means a motor vehicle with
15	a seating capacity of more than ten persons operated by any municipal transit
16	system, nonprofit public transit system as defined in 24 V.S.A. § 5088, or
17	transit authority or transit district created under 24 V.S.A. chapter 127.
18	(b) The driver of a vehicle shall yield the right of way to a public transit
19	bus traveling in the same direction which stopped in the highway right-of-way
20	to discharge or receive passengers and has signaled to reenter the traffic flow.
