Subject: Energy; commerce and trade; energy efficiency standards for appliances and equipment

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend Vermont’s energy efficiency standards for appliances and equipment to include the following products, which are not currently covered by federal energy efficiency standards: computers and monitors; “high CRI” linear fluorescent lamps; deep dimming fluorescent ballasts; faucets, urinals, and water closets; portable electric spas; commercial hot food holding cabinets; and water dispensers.
