2	performance and quality, including identification of the appropriate process
3	and outcome measures:
4	(A) for determining public and health care professional satisfaction
5	with the health system;
6	(B) for utilization of health services;
7	(C) in consultation with the Department of Health and the Director of
8	the Blueprint for Health, for quality of health services and the effectiveness of
9	prevention and health promotion programs, including:
10	(i) the average length of time patients spend interacting with a
11	primary care health care professional and the average length of time patients
12	spend interacting with a specialist; and
13	(ii) the average length of time patients wait between scheduling an
14	appointment and the appointment itself;
