8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create a
9	program establishing "Green Justice Zones." A Green Justice Zone
10	designation would provide pilot funding for at least two communities to
11	establish a community-led, participatory planning, budgeting, and referendum
12	process. This process would implement projects to address social and
13	environmental vulnerabilities in that community. All jobs created to address
14	social and environmental vulnerabilities under this program shall meet or
15	exceed the prevailing industry wage, not less than \$15 an hour. These jobs
16	shall also include access to collective bargaining rights and high-quality
17	benefits to workers. Any program created under this bill would equip workers
18	with the skills they need for any job created. The unionized workforce shall be
19	prioritized for conducting related workforce development programs and
20	recruitment for these jobs will prioritize local workers with low income and
21	workers who are Black, Indigenous, and Persons of Color.
