8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that
9	meetings of the governing boards, and subcommittees thereof, of hospitals and
10	accountable care organizations be subject to the requirements of the Vermont
11	Open Meeting Law.
12	An act relating to extending the requirements of the Open Meeting Law
13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
14	Sec. 1. 1 V.S.A. § 310a is added to read:
15	§ 310a. APPLICATION TO HOSPITALS AND ACCOUNTABLE CARE
16	ORGANIZATIONS
17	(a) Every meeting of a governing board, or a subcommittee thereof, of the
18	following entities shall be subject to the requirements of this subchapter:
19	(1) a hospital required to be licensed under 18 V.S.A. chapter 43, except
20	for the Brattleboro Retreat; and

1	(2) an accountable care organization that meets the criteria of 42 U.S.C.
2	§ 1395jjj(b) and is composed primarily of persons licensed in Vermont to
3	provide health care services.
4	(b) Records in the custody of a hospital or accountable care organization
5	that is not a public agency, which would be exempt from public inspection and
6	copying under 1 V.S.A. § 317 if in the custody of a public agency, shall be
7	deemed exempt from public inspection and copying and therefore eligible for
8	discussion in executive session under 1 V.S.A. § 313(a)(6).

11	(a) No person or governmental unit may establish, conduct, or maintain a
12	hospital in this state State without first obtaining a license therefor in the
13	manner hereinafter provided.
14	(b) Every meeting of a governing board, or a subcommittee thereof, of a
15	hospital required to be licensed under this chapter, except the Brattleboro
16	Retreat, shall be subject to the requirements of the Vermont Open Meeting
17	Law, 1 V.S.A. chapter 5, subchapter 2, in accordance with 1 V.S.A. § 310a.
