15	To implement the policy of section 901 of this title, the department of
16	health shall be responsible for:

18	(8) Establishing, by rule, levels of individual certification and
19	application forms for advanced emergency medical care. The commissioner
20	shall use the guidelines established by the National Highway Traffic Safety

1	Administration (NHTSA) in the U.S. Department of Transportation as a
2	standard or other comparable standards, except that a felony conviction shall
3	not necessarily disqualify an applicant and that recertification requirements for
4	emergency medical personnel shall be governed by subdivision (9) of this
5	section instead of NHSTA guidelines or other comparable standards. The rules
6	shall also provide that:

8	(C) Unless otherwise provided under this section, an individual
9	seeking any level of certification shall be required to pass an examination
10	approved by the commissioner for that level of certification. Written and
11	practical examinations shall not be required for recertification; however, to To
12	maintain certification, all individuals shall complete a specified number of
13	hours of continuing education as established by rule by the commissioner, and
14	in certain cases an examination, pursuant to subdivision (9) of this section.

16	(9)(A) Administering continuing education requirements and
17	examinations for emergency medical personnel. Each level of emergency
18	medical personnel shall complete the corresponding requirements once every
19	two years as follows:
20	(i) a first responder shall complete:

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1	(I) 12 hours of continuing education on subjects specified by
2	the department by rule; and
3	(II) a written and skills examination;
4	(ii) a basic emergency medical technician shall complete:
5	(I) 24 hours of continuing education on subjects specified by
6	the department by rule; and
7	(II) a written and skills examination;
8	(iii) an intermediate or advanced emergency medical technician
9	shall complete:
10	(I) 40 hours of continuing education on subjects specified by
11	the department by rule; and
12	(II) a written and skills examination; and
13	(iv) a paramedic shall complete 72 hours of continuing education
14	on subjects specified by the department by rule.
15	(B) The department shall adopt such rules as are necessary to carry
16	out the provisions of this subdivision (9).
