16	from the Vermont Clean Energy Development Fund to a permanent solar
17	energy rebate initiative. A person who owns a single-family or multifamily
18	residence within the State and installs a solar photovoltaic system for
19	residential use with a peak generating capacity of 15 kilowatts or less shall be
