12 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to direct the  
13 Vermont Principals Association and other interested parties to identify the  
14 Vermont secondary schools that use teacher advisory groups and other groups  
15 designed to ensure that every student has a personal relationship with at least  
16 one adult in the school, to explore how each of these schools implements its  
17 teacher advisory system, and to develop best practices guidelines that would be  
18 available for other schools to replicate.
