12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14	§ 852. FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES
15	(a) The health access oversight committee shall earry on monitor, oversee,
16	and provide a continuing review of the operation of the Medicaid program and
17	all Medicaid waiver programs that may affect the administration and
18	beneficiaries of these programs health care and human services programs in
19	Vermont when the general assembly is not in session.

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1	(b) In conducting its review oversight and in order to fulfill its duties, the
2	committee shall may consult the following:
3	(1) Consumers and advocacy groups regarding their satisfaction and
4	<del>complaints</del> .
5	(2) Health care providers regarding their satisfaction and complaints.
6	(3) The department of Vermont health access.
7	(4) The department of banking, insurance, securities, and health care
8	administration.
9	(5) The department of health.
10	(6) The department for children and families.
11	(7) The department of disabilities, aging, and independent living.
12	(8) The department of mental health.
13	(9) The agency of human services.
14	(10) The agency of administration.
15	(11) The Green Mountain Care board.
16	(12) The director of health care reform.
17	$\frac{(6)}{(13)}$ The attorney general.
18	$\frac{(7)(14)}{(14)}$ The health care ombudsman.

1	(c) The committee shall work with, assist, and advise other committees of
2	the general assembly, members of the executive branch, and the public on
3	matters relating to the state Medicaid program and other state health care and
4	human services programs. Annually, no later than January 15, the committee
5	shall report its recommendations to the governor and the general assembly.

7	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
