Subject: Motor vehicles; law enforcement; traffic safety; automated law
enforcement; traffic cameras; automated license plate recognition
(ALPR) systems; automated traffic law enforcement (ATLE) systems

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow the
current automated license plate recognition (ALPR) systems statutes to sunset
on July 1, 2024 and proposes to enact new laws that allow for the use of ALPR
systems and automated traffic law enforcement (ATLE) systems to be used for
legitimate law enforcement purposes, including traffic safety, which could
involve the use of ATLE systems incorporating radar and cameras at one or
more of the following: work zones, school zones, areas with a high incidence
of crashes, areas with a high incidence of speeding, and intersections with
traffic control signals.
