15	(a) On or before January 1, 2013, the department shall develop a program
16	to certify operators of equipment used to change, alter, or modify the course,
17	current, or cross section of any watercourse under section 1021 of this title.
18	The secretary may adopt rules establishing standards and specifications for the
19	accreditation of equipment operators, including mandatory topics of instruction

and the knowledge and performance standards that must be demonstrated by

1	proposed operators. Such standards shall be designed to protect water
2	resources, water quality, fish and wildlife, and fish and wildlife habitat.
3	(b) The secretary shall certify an equipment operator to change, alter, or
4	modify the course, current, or cross section of any watercourse when such a
5	person successfully completes the program required under subsection (a) of
6	this section and any rules adopted by the secretary thereunder.
7	(c) Beginning January 1, 2013, no person shall change, alter, or modify the
8	course, current, or cross section of any watercourse under section 1021 of this
9	title without first being accredited by the secretary, including a person
10	operating under subsection 1021(b) or (d) of this title.

12	§ 1022. APPLICATION FOR ALTERATION
13	A person proposing to change, alter or modify the course, current, or cross
14	section of a watercourse shall apply in writing to the secretary for a permit to
15	do so. The application shall describe the location and purpose of the proposed
16	change and, shall be accompanied by the maps and plans and other information
17	the secretary shall direct, and shall identify the operator certified under section
18	1021a of this title to conduct the activity authorized by the permit. A
19	conformed copy shall be simultaneously filed with the town clerk of the town

in which the proposed alteration is located, and mailed to each owner of

- 1 property that abuts or is opposite the land where the alteration is to take place.
