13	In addition, if a supervisory union or any of its member districts has not used
14	or encumbered the Medicaid funds allocated under this section for the intended
15	purposes within six months of the date on which they were paid to the
16	supervisory union, then the funds held in excess of six months shall be
17	deposited into the education fund.
18	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
19	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2010, and shall apply to Medicaid funds
20	paid to a supervisory union on or after that date.
