Subject: Education; school districts; Medicaid funds

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require a supervisory union or
school district to use or encumber Medicaid funds within six months of receipt.

An act relating to supervisory unions, school districts, and Medicaid funds

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 16 V.S.A. § 2959a(g) is amended to read:

(g) Remaining reimbursed funds shall be deposited into the education fund.

In addition, if a supervisory union or any of its member districts has not used
or encumbered the Medicaid funds allocated under this section for the intended
purposes within six months of the date on which they were paid to the
supervisory union, then the funds held in excess of six months shall be
deposited into the education fund.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2010, and shall apply to Medicaid funds
paid to a supervisory union on or after that date.
